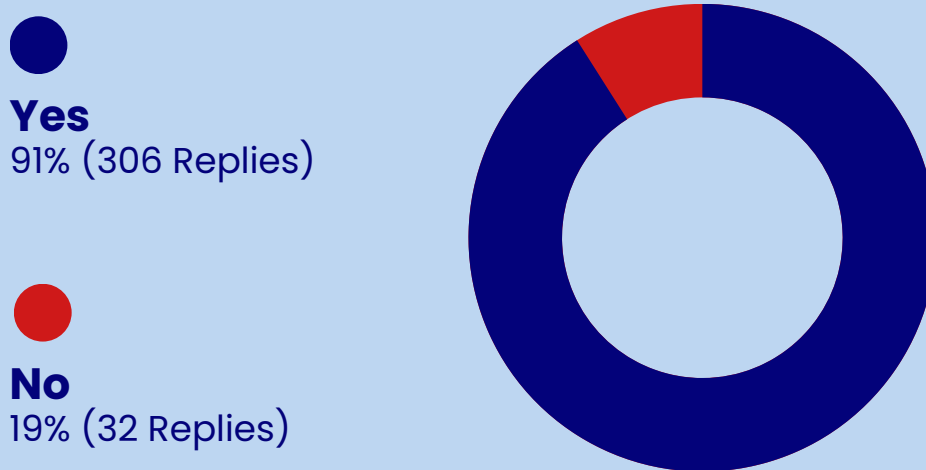

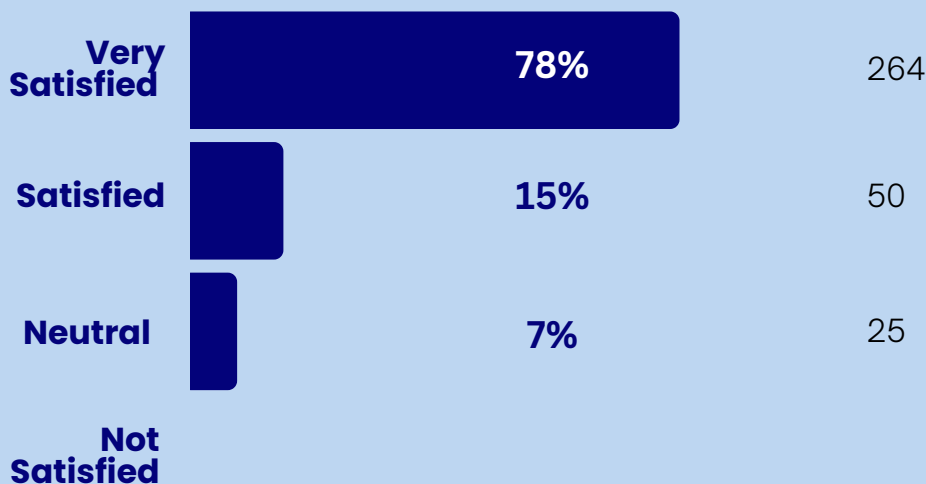

Is this your first Common Core Boot Camp Event?



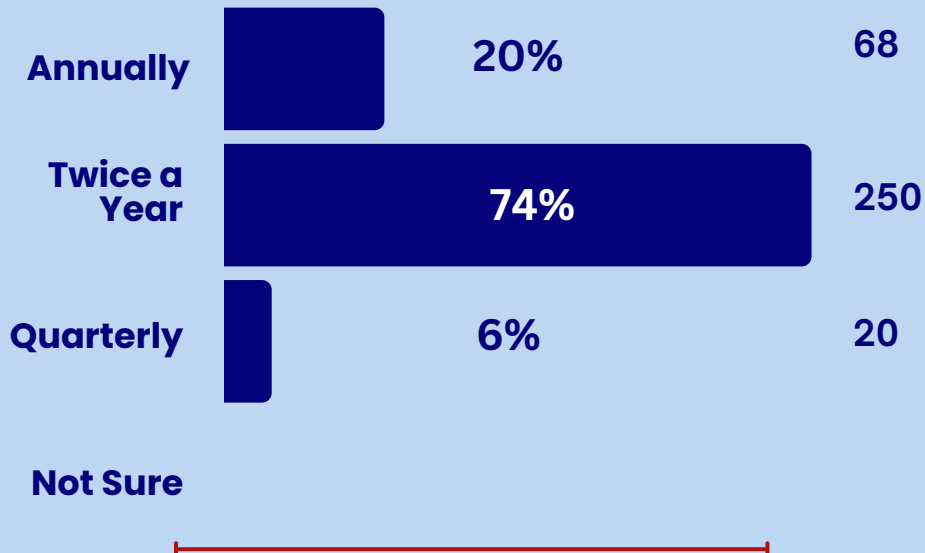
How would you describe your overall satisfaction with Common Core Boot Camp?



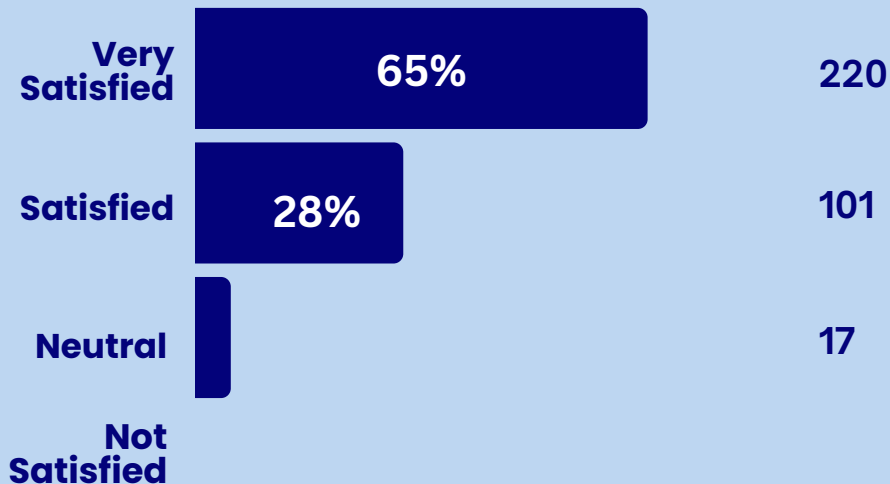
Common Core Boot Camp Fact:

How often should Common Core Boot Camp be held?



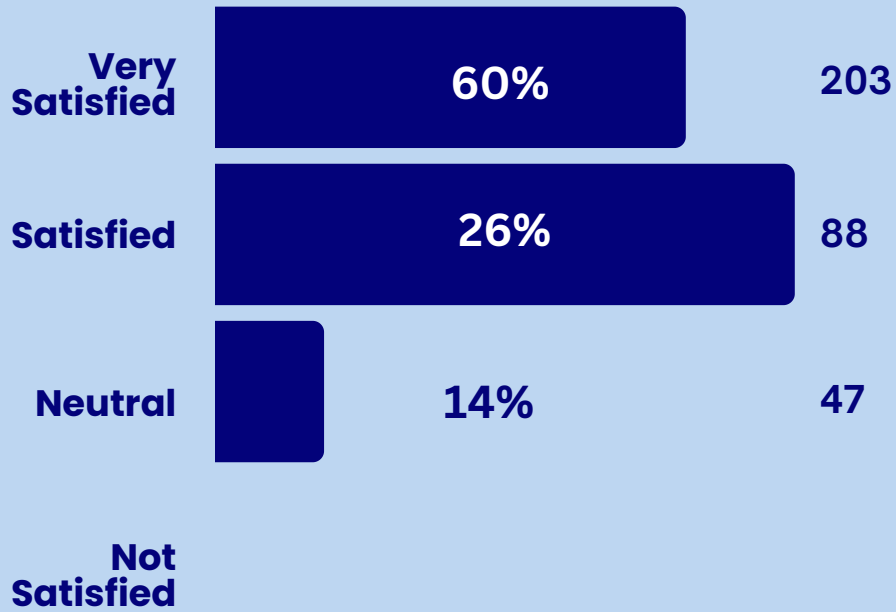
Did you find the Common Core Boot Camp to be a good value for the cost of admission?



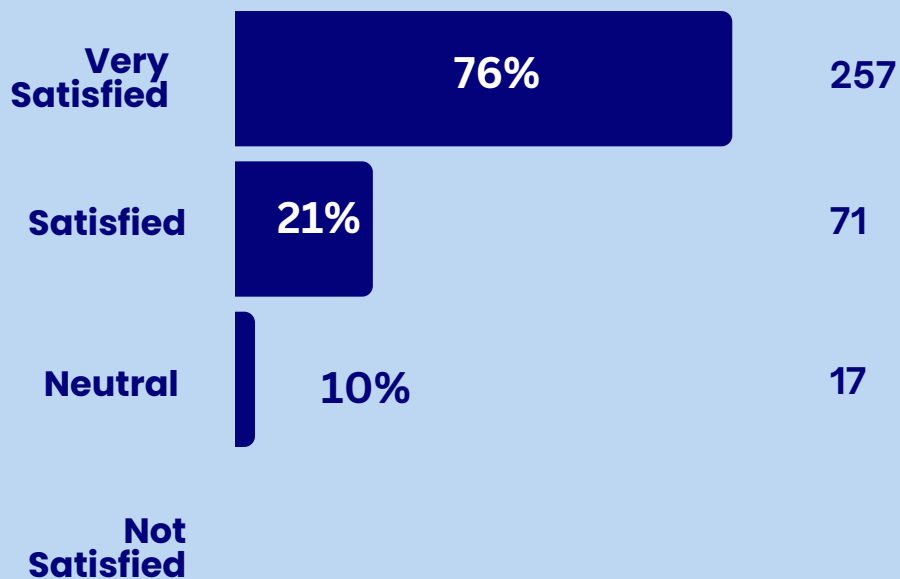
My only criticism is that I wish it was longer. This should be a 2-day event! All of my sessions were so good and I met some great people. I just needed more time. Please have another boot camp soon.
